Anna Nilsson Bobeck (the mother of Christina Marie Persson (Jonsson) Borgstrom

PER or PAR JONSSON and ANNA NILSSON BOBECK were the parents of Christina Marie (Persson) Borgstrom and he was born January 3, 1819 at Malmo, Sweden. He married Anna Nilsson Bobeck on November 27, 1840. She was born November 1, 1811, at West Alstad, Malmohus, Sweden.

According to the records in Svedala "Husforhorslangder" (which means the yearly hearings of the members of the parishes at which time a record was kept of the people) in the years 1848 to 1855 from the book it states that the family moved from Aggarp 8 to Aggarp 2. Husband Per Jonsson emigrated to Denmark in 1859 and that the wife, Anna Nilsson (Nilsson) moved out in 1874 on the 24 day of October to Caroli, in Malmo.

From the books above mentioned no more than five children have been recorded in the records had in the custody of the County Archives. These five children moved out according to the following information:

Nils, born Sept. 20, 1841, moved in 1857 (16 years old) to Flossie.

Christina Persdotter (Persson) born September 27, 1843, moved out unmarried to Caroli in Malmo in 1862 (19 years old).

Karna, born June 14, 1846, moved out in 1860 to Ronneby, Blekinge County (14 years old).

Peter, born March 4, 1849, moved out April 23, 1869 (less than 20 years old) to Flossie.

Bengta Persdotter, born July 13, 1851, moved out November 16, 1867 (16) to Hylle Parish.
