KNOW ALL MEN by these presents that wee JANE CARTER, WM. CARTER & GILES CARTER of County of Richmond are held and firmly bound unto the Worshipful! his Maties. Justices of the Peace for said County in the full & just sums of One hundred pounds Sterling, to the which payment well and truly to be made wee bind ourselves our heirs firmly by these presents; Sealed with our Seals & Dated the 1st day of June 1720

THE CONDITION of this Obligation is such that if ye above bound JANE CARTER, Admrx. of all the goods chattles & creditts of WM: CARTER JUNR., deced, doe make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all the goods chattles & creditts of the said deced., and the same see made doe exhibit into the County Court of Richmond at such time as he shall be thereto required by said Cout. and ye same goods chattles & credlus doe well and truly administer according to Law: And further do make a just & true acct. of her actings and doings therein when thereto required by said Court, and shall pay unto such persons as the Justices by their order or Judgment shall direct pursuant to the Laws in that case made and provided; And if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will and Testamt, was made by the sd. deced., and the Exr. or Exrs. therein named doe exhibitt the same in ye Court mateing request to have it allowed and approved, accordingly, if the sd. JANE CARTER being thereunto required doe render & deliver up her Letters of Admon, approbation of such Testamt. being had and made in sd. Court; Then this Obligation to be void & of none effect, otherwise to remain in full force and vertue

Indenture 30th October 1733 between WILLIAM CARTER SENR. King George County Planter & WILLIAM CARTER JUNR. Son of WILLIAM & JANE CARTER of other part .. witnesseth that WILLIAM CARTER SENR. do willingly & voluntarily give to my well beloved Godson the son of WILLIAM & JANE CARTER one tract where his father lived it being part of parcel that did formerly belong to old CHARLES SNEAD beginning .. Bever dam; Spring run to land that was formerly GILES MATHEWS thence Ivy point near Griffins mill .. 100 acres .. which said land WILLIAM CARTER do give to him leaving my daughter MARGARET free liberty to work & tend on the same what she shall see fit for the term of 16 years if she keeps unmarried but when she marries in the term of the 16 years to surrender which land I give to my grandson & his male heirs lawfully begotten .. if no heirs then it shall fall to my grandson JOHN CARTER the son of GYLES & MARY CARTER ..
